After something a bit different? Axe throwing could be the activity for you! Hosted in a pub, you can grab a drink and some grub once you've finished!




### Stoke Park

# Surrey Hills

## Beautiful walks in the area



The Surrey Hills is a 422 km<sup>2</sup> Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty (AONB), which principally covers parts of the **North Downs** and **Greensand Ridge** in Surrey, England. The AONB was designated in 1958 and adjoins the **Kent Downs AONB** to the east and the **South Downs National Park** in the south west. It is one of the 46 nationally protected landscapes in the UK.



You'll discover an extensive footpath network, open commons, inspiring views, attractive market towns, villages and much more. Well-known iconic sites such as **Box Hill**, **Leith Hill Tower**, the **Devil's Punchbowl**, and **Newlands Corner** to the more unusual including the **Tillingbourne waterfall**, **Wilberforce memorial & Atlantic Wall**.



Just a short walk from Guildford city centre, a walk through **chantry wood** will lead you to **St. Martha's church** which offers beautiful views of the rolling hills. A little further will take you to the picturesque village of **Shere** where the popular Christmas film 'The Holiday' was filmed.

## Things to do in the capital

### NQ64
