# Role of Practice Assessor (PA)

- » Students nominated to a PA for a placement or a series of placements
- » Students are nominated to a Practice Assessor who is on the same part of the register as the student intends to enter
- » PA is not simultaneously the PS and PA for the same student
- » Expected to appropriately raise concerns regarding student conduct, competence and achievement
- » Make and record objective, evidence- based assessments on conduct, proficiency and achievement drawing on student records, direct observations, student self – reflection and other resources
- » Periodically observe the student across environments in order to inform decisions for assessment and progression

## PA Role cont..

- » Co ordinate feedback from Practice Supervisors any other Practice Assessors about their decisions
- » Works in partnership with the nominated Academic Assessor to evaluate and recommend the student for progression
- » PA have an understanding of the student's learning and achievement in theory
- » Communication and collaboration between Practice and Academic Assessors is scheduled for relevant points in programme structure and student progression
- » PA for students on approved prescribing programmes must be a prescriber, not necessarily NMC or same part of register
- » Maintain current knowledge and expertise relevant for the proficiencies and programme outcomes
