AWERB Committee discussed, and agreed by majority vote to approve subject to amendments: - Humane end point to be determined - Study to be adjusted to severe, or a strong reasoning to be provided by the PPLh as to why it should remain as moderate. - Further clarity should be provided on the different experimental 'pathways' animals may take and how this impacts what animals' 'experience'. - More detail needed on the power analysis - Confirmation needed - % of non-responders that will be removed from the experiment. - PPLh to confirm animal numbers with statistician Majority of committee approved PPL subject to satisfactory addressing of points raised. There was one dissenting vote: individual felt that harm did not outweigh the benefit of the study.
